How do you spend your **time** enriching your spiritual life and sharing your gifts with your parish and community?

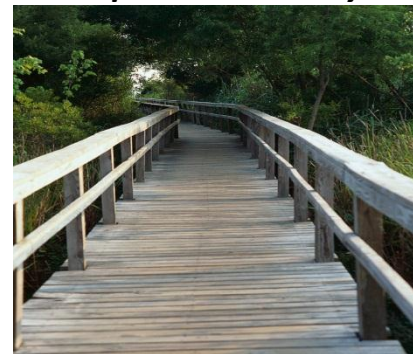
