### FROM THE PASTORS’ DESK

Why is there a need for a new translation of the mass? Well, it is not exactly a new translation of the entire mass what we are looking at a new translation of some of the prayers, an addition of more feast days for some of the new Saints and a few slight changes in the way some familiar parts of the mass are worded. You see during the Jubilee Year in 2000, Pope John Paul II issued the third edition of the Latin text of the Roman Missal. This new edition included a number of new texts that required translation into English. Additionally, in the years following the Second Vatican Council there arose the desire to have a more formal and literal translation of the original Latin texts. So the new translation will utilize all that we have learned over the last two generations of celebrating the Liturgy in the vernacular to provide us a translation of the texts that will help us to reflect even more deeply on our celebration of the Eucharist which truly is at the center of who we are as Church.
